Students reflected that it was inspiring to see people so passionate about this cause.</p> <p>No bench marks were met. It was difficult for me to match the civic engagement activity with the rubric. I felt that the students in general responded well to the project but I had a difficult time assessing the level of proficiency. I would probably reword some of the language in the rubric. Since all participating in the pilot project used the same rubric it was pretty generic. This college has it's own rubric to assess the outcome and will be using it instead.</p>
	<p><b>Description of Assessment:</b> This project included researching health care costs, and a civic engagement activity with Health Care for All Oregon. Students will be assessed on their reflections of their civic engagement activity. Students were given a choice between asking five people to fill out the Health Care Survey, participating in a HCAO information session, or writing a letter to a representative.</p> <p><b>Assessment Type:</b> Writing Assignment</p> <p><b>Benchmark:</b> Eighty per cent proficiency in all 3 categories.</p>
